WHAT DO YOU NEED TO APPLY?

1. Completed Admission/Scholarship Application. Apply online at admissions.okstate.edu/apply.
2. \$40 nonrefundable application fee (or fee waiver).
3. Official sealed transcript (dated less than three months old) from **each** college or university attended.
4. Official high school transcript containing your class rank, GPA, ACT or SAT score(s) and graduation date (if you have less than 24 college-level credit hours).

TRANSFERRING TO OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY

Deadlines to submit the Undergraduate Application for Admission and Scholarships: **Fall-entering students: Feb. 1 for priority scholarship consideration; July 1 final scholarship deadline. Spring-entering students: Oct. 15 for priority scholarship consideration; The Friday before spring classes begins is the final scholarship deadline.**

REGENTS DISTINGUISHED TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIP (OKLAHOMA RESIDENTS ONLY)	The Regents Distinguished Transfer Scholarship is renewable for up to two years with a 2.0 overall GPA. No academic area of emphasis required.	\$2,500 per year (\$5,000 two-year total)	Eligible students must have 24+ earned credit hours <i>and</i> a 3.25 college GPA.
TRANSFER OUT-OF-STATE ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP* (OUT-OF-STATE ONLY)	The Transfer Out-of-State Achievement Scholarship is renewable for up to two years with a 2.0 overall GPA. No academic area of emphasis required.	\$5,000 per year (\$10,000 two-year total)	Eligible students must have 24+ earned credit hours <i>and</i> a 3.25 college GPA.
TRANSFER OUT-OF-STATE LEGACY SCHOLARSHIP* (OUT-OF-STATE ONLY)	The Transfer Out-of-State Legacy Scholarship is renewable for up to three years with a 2.0 cumulative graduation/retention GPA. No academic area of emphasis required.	\$5,000 per year (\$15,000 three-year total)	Out-of-state students whose parents or grandparents graduated from OSU are eligible.

Students must maintain a minimum GPA and number of credit hours per semester to renew scholarship opportunities each year. Renewable scholarship qualifications may vary. Deadlines, figures and admission requirements are subject to change. Visit admissions.okstate.edu for the most up-to-date information on admission and scholarships at Oklahoma State University.

**Students eligible for both the Transfer Out-of-State Achievement Scholarship and the Transfer Out-of-State Legacy Scholarship will only receive the scholarship that provides the greatest benefit to the student.*
